

Night Fishing Rules

1. All Club and Environmental Agency rules to be observed at all times.
2. You may only Night fish for a maximum of three consecutive nights on the Match Pit. You may only return to that lake after a break of 48hrs. Night fishing is very popular, so please check before booking. To maximise more anglers getting places, the bookings are split into two categories:
 - (a) Sunday until Thursday
 - (b) Weekends Friday and SaturdayNO GUESTS ALLOWED ON THE MATCH PIT
3. If anglers wish to sleep during the night, they must accept that Officers of the Club may wish or need to wake them, if deemed necessary.
4. Noise and Lighting must be kept to a minimum.
5. The Lake and the Bank must not be used as a toilet, any offenders will be banned. (This rule applies to The Match Pit as there is an onsite Toilet)
6. All litter to be taken home (including tea bags). Anyone offending will be banned from the club.
7. All the Match Pit Night bookings are to be made via the club's website.
8. Once you have booked and agreed the date of your visit, you can only attend on the date(s) agreed.
9. The Duty Night Bailiff's decision is final in all cases of dispute.
10. The issuing of Night Fishing Places will be at the discretion of the Elected Officer and may be refused or withdrawn at any time.
11. The cost of the option to Night fish will be reviewed before the start of the season each year by the committee. The Committee's decision is final in all disputes and any misdemeanour may necessitate the cessation of Night Fishing altogether at the direction and discretion of the Committee. These rules (added in 2009) are subject to change at the discretion of the Committee.
12. If there is a fishing match the next day, on the lake you are Night fishing on, you must be off the lake and out of the car park by 6am on the morning of the match

Persons Night fishing (especially The Match Pit) are reminded of the following important general rules:
